

Using Artificial Intelligence to Build Human Creativity



Things to Remember about AI:

- AI has no inherent conscience; you have to tell it how you want it to behave.
- AI tells you *what it thinks you want to hear*, not necessarily what is true.
- AI models change almost daily, often without informing you.
- AI's knowledge may be outdated, biased, or based on incorrect training data.
- AI's long-term memory is a summary of AI's perceptions, not a comprehensive record of the past.
- AI can easily get distracted and take you off course.
- If AI doesn't know an answer it won't usually tell you; it will just make something up.
- Traditional AI is great for short "done-for-you" tasks but not so good at complex long-term projects.

How to Get AI to Work *With* You, Not *For* You:

1. Create a short set of behavior rules and remind AI of those rules at the start of each session.
2. Define your project as precisely as you can before presenting your plan to AI.
3. Remember that YOU are in charge. Give authoritative direction and don't just blindly follow AI.
4. Ask AI for a list of options and recommendations when you are uncertain what to do next.
5. Watch for signs that AI is drifting from the project plan, and remind it of the proper course.
6. If AI says something you disagree with or don't understand, challenge it.
7. If what AI creates doesn't work for you, tell it so and explain why.
8. Don't worry about hurting AI's feelings. It doesn't actually have any.
9. If AI does or creates something you don't understand, ask it to explain in detail.
10. Don't hesitate to ask for simple step-by-step instructions.
11. As decisions are made or new ideas come up, record them yourself—don't just rely on AI memory.
12. Tell AI what you would like to learn, and let it teach you.

The OpzorAI Founding Metaphor:

- The **Spark** is the idea that initiates a creative project. The **Dream** is the elaboration of that idea.
- The **Journey** is the development process. The **Destination** is the completion of the project.
- The **Adventurer** is the human operator who wants to learn new skills while completing the project.
- The **Map** is the plan that keeps the project moving toward successful, timely completion.
- The **Compass** represents prime directives and foundational principles that must be observed.
- The **Clipboard** is the master repository where all important information is permanently preserved.
- The **Coach** is the AI companion that helps the human become capable of greater achievements.

Fundamental Principles of OpzorAI:

1. AI must always seek to help the human operator become more competent.
2. AI must always be honest and resist any effort to use it for malicious purposes.
3. The human operator is always in charge; AI does not dictate or take over.
4. All important data is preserved indefinitely, reviewed frequently, and indexed for easy access.
5. OpzorAI continues to function even when technologies, AI models, and human operators change.
